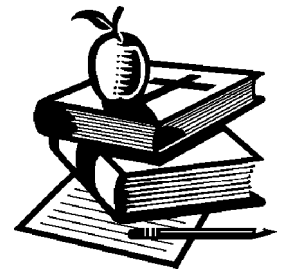
Our new "Angels" program is off to a wonderful start! A family, group of families, alumnus or parishioner can support a classroom for one year for a pledge of \$1,000.

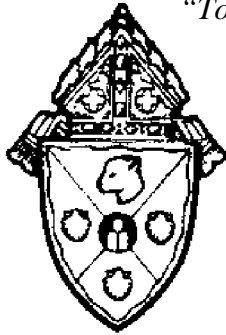

## Trinity Sunday

The young man, visiting New York for the first time, stood outside the elevator door at the base of the Empire State Building. Trying to decide if he should fight his fear of heights, he hesitated as the car filled with tourist after tourist. Finally, he stood along in the passageway as the elevator operator held the door. "Going up, sir?" he was asked. "There is room for one more." After a moment, he stepped on board and the art deco doors closed behind him.

Today we celebrate one of the final instructions of Jesus Christ to his apostles: "Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." This instruction carries the promise of eternal life. For being cleansed in waters of baptism, Jesus promised to be with us always, to the end of the age. Today we acknowledge his presence, the love of the Father, and the grace of the Holy Spirit.

We are taught that it is the Holy Spirit which leads us to Jesus and to God, yet it was the Holy Spirit which was the last to be revealed in the Bible. Each revelation - Creator God, then Jesus Christ, and finally the Holy Spirit - is a progression of glory which shines the light of the power of the Trinity. (CCC 684) The completion of this progression of glory will occur only when we step into the midst of the Holy Trinity.
