The Servants of the Lord and the Virgin of Matará (www.servidoras.org or www.ssvmmissions.org), a missionary Institute of religious sisters, are happy to be given the opportunity to speak at Our Lady of Lourdes for the mission appeal on October 24/25. For this reason missionaries do not receive much help from the local people who very often, themselves, lack even basic necessities. Thank you, Msgr. McNamara, for giving us this opportunity to speak at Our Lady of Lourdes and share with you about our mission in Papua. As we daily strive to help those in need, we are most grateful to all of you for your prayers, contributions and generosity, truly a grace from God and a consolation for our missionary. Please be assured of our prayers for all of you, as well!





