

So, there was this guy... and this guy had to leave to become a Pastor in Smithtown (by way of a 5-month long deployment in Kuwait!).

In the midst of my sadness at leaving for a new assignment, my overriding feeling is one of gratitude. As I tried to explain (through my tears), I especially want to thank you for allowing me to become a part of your family. As I said on Sunday, priests do not have families, in the sense that we do not have children and grandchildren.

But I have always considered my parish to be my family. We have been together in good times and in bad times, in sickness (particularly the long COVID-19 crisis) and in health. From baptisms to first communions to weddings to anointings of the sick to funerals, you have allowed me to be a part of your family life and I deeply appreciate that.

While I have to say "good-bye" in terms of being assigned to St. Patrick's Church in Smithtown, I am confident that there will be many times that we will see each other again. Please be assured of my prayers for you. May the Lord Jesus continue to bless you and guide you and may God always hold you in the palm of His hand.

I would like to conclude with this quote from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians (1:3-7,9):

I thank my God whenever I think of you; and every time I pray for all of you, I pray with joy, remembering how you have helped to spread the Good News from the day you first heard it right up to the present. I am quite certain that the One who began this good work in you will see that it finished when the Day of Christ Jesus comes.

You have a permanent place in my heart... My prayer for you is that your love for each other may increase more and more.






