Corpus Christi Procession on June 2nd

We will be having an outside procession around the property of the church on June 2nd because it is the Feast of Corpus Christi (*the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ*). Please join us in procession following the 12:30pm Mass. We will process with the Blessed Sacrament under a beautiful canopy accompanied by 4 tiki torches, 8 decorative umbrellas from India, our first communion children, the parish priests, deacons, altar servers, and more. There will also be recorded music along the way to help us sing to the Lord. We will have three short stops along the procession for us to pause and pray. The procession concludes back in the church with benediction. The whole procession is approximately 30–35 minutes long. Those who cannot process can remain in the church for the final benediction. Please join us in this procession as we honor the Lord and give him the glory due him. All are welcome.

The feast of Corpus Christi fulfills Jesus' promise when he said, *"I will be with you every day until the end of time"*. He said he would come to us and not leave us as orphans. Jesus comes to us at every Mass in Holy Communion. Why? To feed us, love us, heal us, help us, and strengthen us not only in our personal lives but to witness to others. God is so good that he wants to give us what we cannot give ourselves. The Eucharist is also the sign of unity among believers, as St. Paul said. Jesus told us in John's gospel, if you do not eat my body and drink my blood you will have no life within you. Let us receive Holy Communion on June 2nd with profound gratitude and process after the 12:30pm Mass with joy over the Love God has for us.

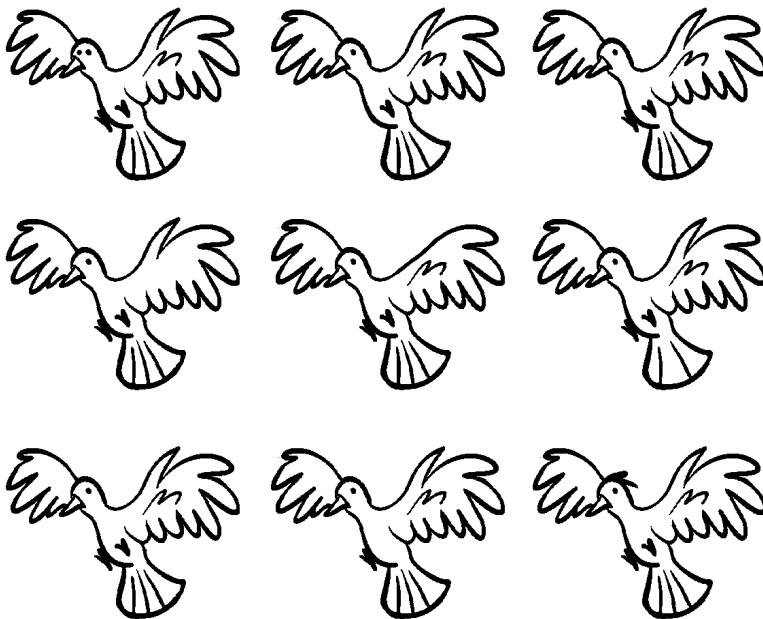
