



First Communion Reflections - 2024

It has been our custom for the family of a First Communion child to give an introduction to a Parent Prayer at the conclusion of the Liturgy. The following is the reflection given by the family of **Matthew Chartrand** on April 20, 2024.



Good morning.

We would like to congratulate all of the boys and girls making their First Holy Communion today. You put in the hard work for this very special day and sacrament, and we are all happy to celebrate this with you.

We are here today to present our son, Matthew, along with all of you for the reception of the First Eucharist. My family has been members of this parish for 34 years. We have celebrated many family sacraments at Our Lady of Lourdes over the years including Baptisms, Communions, Confirmations and, of course, Weddings. I have had the honor of being one of the Catechists here these past two years.

Our faith is important to us because it provides us with a purpose to serve and love God everyday. Our faith leads us to help others and treat others as we would like to be treated and it is our hope that in doing this we can make the world a better place. As parents, we would like to say thank you to Our Lady of Lourdes Parish and to my fellow catechists. Thank you for all your support for these children as they continue their journey with God.

Tips for Spotting a Scam. Don't fall for it! Here's what to know and do:

- First, Fr. Dennis or Fr. Charles will *never* contact a parishioner directly with an emergency request for cash or gift cards. Messages asking parishioners to help fulfill a need would come through the parish's official communication channels or be accomplished through a collection approved by the diocese. If you're not sure about a text or email you've received, do not engage or respond. Call the Parish Office right away to notify a staff member. In addition, please note that neither your parish, nor the diocese, will ever sell or give away parishioners' personal information.
- Often times with text messages, a scam can be identified by looking at the phone number. If the area code is not local, it's likely a scam. If you are contacted by a scammer, report it to the Parish Office. If you can, capture screen shots of the correspondence on your phone or laptop and email those to the Parish Office.
- File a report through the Federal Trade Commission's Complaint Assistant which helps the FTC detect patterns of fraud and abuse.
- If you suspect that your Facebook account has been hacked, CBS News offers these tips on how to tell if your account's been hacked and what to do about it at: <u>https://www.cbsnews.com/news/how-to-tell-if-your-facebook-has-been-hacked-and-what-you-can-do/</u>. You can also check the "help center" on Facebook for information on hacked and fake (cloned) accounts.


